Re: Required Calculator for 2017-18 (TI-84 or TI-84+ are preferred)

All high school students taking a math and/or science course are required to have a graphing calculator. The implementation of this policy will benefit parents and students by only having to buy one calculator for math and science, and it can be used during all four years of high school. It is recommended that students have a Texas Instruments model **TI-84** or **TI-84+** in order to avoid issues with different operating systems among students and teachers. **Important Note:** the TI-89, TI-92, and TI-Nspire CAS are not permitted to be used on the SAT exam.

In order to help parents budget for this purchase and find the best price for a new or refurbished calculator, we are sending this notification letter out to parents with some possible websites that parents can utilize in their planning.
