

Getting Started at JJC

Visit the Admissions page at www.jjc.edu/admissions for a complete list of steps to get you started. Advising for new students is provided through New Student Orientation.

Step 1. Apply to Joliet Junior College.

- Submit your application by visiting www.jjc.edu/admissions
- Access your JJC account information at <http://www.jjc.edu/getting-started/register-courses/idusernamepassword-help>
- Submit your high school transcript or high school equivalency (GED, HiSET, TASC) transcript to the Admissions office at Main Campus, A-1020. These must be on file for math and science placement.

Step 2. (Optional): Apply for financial aid and JJC scholarships.

- Visit the financial aid website for application information and filing dates at www.jjc.edu/financial-aid.
- This is recommended, but not required, in order to complete the admissions process.

Step 3. Take Placement Testing or Submit your ACT, GED, HiSET, PARCC, or SAT scores to the Admissions Office.

- Students with college credit in English and Math may be exempted from placement testing. If you have previously completed college level coursework, submit an official transcript for evaluation and/or alert your counselor/advisor to ensure accurate placement.

Step 4. Complete New Student Orientation

- To sign up for an on-campus session you must have an admissions application on file AND complete ALL placement testing or submit current, eligible ACT, GED, HiSET, PARCC, or SAT test scores.

Step 1. New Student Presentation

Here you will learn important information about academic programs, student support services, and college policies and procedures. Choose to do your presentation either online (Blended) or on-campus (Traditional). ***The Traditional presentation option has limited availability.**

Step 2. New Student Advising

New Student Group Advising Sessions

- **All new first-time/full-time students and those first-time/part-time students seeking first semester advising are required to complete New Student Group Advising.**
- A current admissions application and all appropriate placement scores must be on file before signing up for an on-campus session.
- During this session, you will meet with an Advisor to plan first semester classes, learn how to use JJC technology, and register for classes.
- Bring your reservation ticket and unofficial transcript to your scheduled session.
- There is limited availability for each session. You must sign-up online and in advance.
- Be prepared to stay for the entire length of the session (Blended 1.5 hours, Traditional 2.5 hours).
