PARKING PERMIT
APPLICATION INFORMATION**

PARKING PERMIT APPLICATIONS MUST BE RETURNED TO THE ATTENDANCE OFFICE PRIOR TO THURSDAY, JULY 25, 2019. DO NOT SEND FEES IN WITH THE APPLICATION. FEES WILL BE COLLECTED WHEN PERMITS ARE ISSUED TO STUDENTS ON THE DATES LISTED BELOW:

SENIORS ONLY

Monday August 5, 2019 8:00 am to 2:00 pm

JUNIORS ONLY

Tuesday August 6, 2019 8:00 am to 2:00 pm

MAKE UP

SENIORS AND JUNIORS

Wednesday, August 7, 2019 8:00 am to 2:00 pm

To obtain a permit, you will need ALL the following items returned with your application:

1. Application needs to be completed *entirely* and signed by both parent/guardian and student.
2. Copy of proof of family ownership through valid and current registration and insurance card.
3. Copy of student Driver's License.
4. On the day of permit issuance, you must turn in your \$100.00 parking permit fee. Make checks payable to Plainfield South High School. Do not send this fee in with the application. It will only delay the issuance of the permit.
5. Parking tags are NOT issued on a first come, first serve basis. Students who have turned in their completed form and are current on their school fees will be randomly assigned a parking tag. Seniors with completed applications AND turned in on time will have first priority followed by juniors. However, all applications for parking spots not turned in by the deadline will be issued permits by administration discretion on a first come/first serve basis.
6. Completion of Parking Application does not ensure permit issuance.

Please review the following:

- Issued Permits may NOT be sold, transferred or duplicated due to, but not limited to, early graduation or withdrawal. Tags cannot be shared with another student.
- For the first year of licensing, or until the driver is age 18, whichever occurs first, the number of passengers is limited to ONE person under age 20, unless the additional passenger(s) is a sibling or step-sibling of the driver. After this period, the number of passengers is limited to one in the front seat and the number of safety belts in the back seat.
- Students involved in a vehicle-to-vehicle accident or pedestrian-to-vehicle accident is subject to administrative review and possible loss of parking privileges.
- Reckless/careless driving practices, failure to follow any of the school guidelines, or state laws will not be tolerated on school grounds and may result in loss of parking privileges without a refund for a defined length of time.
