Your signature indicates you have read and understand the information about the **Advantage After School Program- Initial Credit Opportunity**. You may contact your child's counselor if you have questions or need additional information.

- The purpose of the **Advantage After School Program** is for students to earn **additional credits** toward graduation.
- The Advantage Program uses **Edgenuity** which is a computer based program. All courses meet the rigor of common core, state standards as well as our graduation requirements. Each student is given an individualized calendar, target goals, and assignments.
- You will receive login information to monitor your child's progress and attendance.
- Upon successful completion of the Edgenuity online class, your child will receive a PASS grade and earn 0.5 credit. This grade **WILL NOT** be calculated into the cumulative GPA.
- Edgenuity's online classes are **NOT approved by the NCAA Clearinghouse**. If your child is considering participating in college level athletics, he/she should take the traditional class, rather than the online Edgenuity class.
- Consistent attendance and active participation are necessary for your child to successfully complete the enrolled class. In order to complete the Edgenuity class and earn credit by the end of the program, it will be necessary for your child to spend additional time working on coursework independently at home. Students who are not making adequate progress in their coursework may be dropped from the course at the discretion of the program instructor and will receive a FAIL grade on their high school transcript.
- Students will be required to attend the orientation session on Tuesday, September 7, 2021 from 2:15-3:15. After that, they will only be required to attend if they are behind in their daily progress goal or when they are at a unit test. Unit tests must be completed in person. Parents and students will receive an e-mail the morning of class if students are required to attend. Failure to attend or remain on target will result in being dropped from the course without a refund.
- All initial credit courses must be completed by Tuesday, December 7, 2021 in order for students to receive credit.
