**Ticket Sales**

**Tickets will be sold April 10<sup>th</sup> – April 20<sup>th</sup> in the main office after school from 2:10 pm – 3:00 pm, or during lunch periods.**

**At the time of purchase, you must have:**

1. Cash or check for \$80 per person or \$160 per couple made out to Plainfield South High School.
2. Date request form with proper signatures if you are taking a date from another school.
3. Please note that all student accounts must be in good standing order to purchase tickets. This means:
  - 1) Payment plan has been arranged **OR** 2) the account balance is \$0.

**Ticket purchase procedure: At the time of purchase, you will receive a temporary ticket. On the day of prom, you must attend school for periods 1-3. After, you will trade in your temporary ticket for your actual ticket. This will be a sticker that you will need to attach to your ID card. You need to bring this sticker, along with your ID card, to the event for entrance. You must have a form of ID (school ID, driver’s license, or state ID) to enter!**

### Favors

At the time of ticket purchase, you will receive your prom favor (small gift - while supplies last).

### Seating

There is **NO ASSIGNED SEATING**. Tables will be taken on a first come first serve basis.

All students must be seated by 7pm and must remain seated during the entire dinner hour from 7pm to 8pm.

### Pictures

A list of picture packages will be given to you when your tickets are purchased. Bring a check or money order to prom made out to HR Imaging. **DO NOT** make checks out to PSHS. Picture taking will begin at 6pm. Please remember: the doors for prom do not open until 6pm. If you arrive early for pictures, you must remain in the lobby area. Pictures will **NOT** be taken during dinner. They will resume at 8pm after dinner.

### Attire

Attire is considered formal / semi-formal. For men it is appropriate to wear a tuxedo, simple jacket, or a nice shirt and a tie. Ladies: please keep in mind the PSHS dress code.

### **FAQs**

#### **How do I get there?**

Ashton Place: Take 55 North (12 miles) and exit at 273B onto Cass Ave. North (16 miles). Turn right onto Plainfield Rd. (0.4 miles). Take a slight right turn onto 75<sup>th</sup> St. E. (0.6 miles). Turn right into the parking lot.

#### **What do I need to enter?**

You will need your school ID with your sticker ticket on the back. If, for some reason, you lose your sticker ticket, we will have a master list of who purchased them. However, you **MUST HAVE your school ID to check in. DON'T FORGET YOUR ID!** This pertains to both PSHS and non-PSHS students (these guests must have a school ID, a valid state ID, or a driver's license to check in).

#### **Is there a coat check?**

No. We are not responsible for any lost / misplaced items.

#### **Is prom for juniors and seniors only?**

Only PSHS juniors and seniors may purchase prom tickets. Dates, however, may be from any grade level from 9<sup>th</sup> and above; the maximum age allowed into prom is age 20.

#### **Is there a PSHS sponsored post prom event?**

No.

#### **Music?**

All kinds of music will be played. Attendees will have the opportunity to request songs on the night of prom. Please keep in mind that just because you request a song does not guarantee you may hear it; there will be approximately 600 attendees and only three hours to play music.

#### **Do most students come alone or with someone else?**

The purpose of the night is to make it memorable and fun. PSHS attendees arrive at prom alone, with a date, or even in groups. This is left up to the individual.

## Prom Royalty

Prom court voting will be in English classes during the week of April 10<sup>th</sup>. If you are voted in, you will be contacted prior to being added to the official ballot to ensure you want to participate (check your school email). The final vote will be in English classes during the week of prom. "Prom Royalty" (the two seniors with the most votes) will be announced at prom.

## Can I sit with my friends during dinner?

Yes; however, there will NOT be assigned seats at prom. *Get there early!*

## Are you allowed to come and go as you please?

No. If an attendee needs to return to their car in extreme circumstances, he or she will be escorted by a dean. Once an attendee leaves prom, he or she is not allowed to return.

## What are the drug, alcohol and tobacco policies?

Prom has a ZERO TOLERANCE POLICY. Anyone suspected of being under the influence of alcohol or any drug will be removed from the prom area and their parents will be notified. The ticket fee will not be refunded. Cigarette smoking and vaping are not allowed, and no one can bring drinks of any kind (water, soda, power drinks, etc.) to prom.

## Wilco Students

If you are unable to pick up your ticket(s) after 3<sup>rd</sup> period, your ticket(s) will be available to pick up in Student Services.

### **Plainfield South High School Prom 2023 Rules**

**Since this is a school function, all Plainfield School District 202 rules apply to ALL students and their guests, regardless of age. They will be strictly enforced. Please be aware of the following:**

1. Only PSHS students and pre-approved guests will be allowed to enter. A school ID is required for entrance to all PSHS students. A photo ID is required for all non-PSHS guests. Failure to present proper ID will result in refusal of entrance with no refund of ticket price.
2. **A student may only bring one guest.** Minimum grade level is 9<sup>th</sup> grade and maximum age is 20.
3. No smoking or smoking materials will be permitted at any time for anyone, regardless of age.
4. No controlled substances: alcohol, marijuana, look-alikes, etc.
5. There will be no admittance to Ashton Place if tickets have not been previously purchased. **We will not sell tickets at the door!**
6. Once a student and his/her/their guest enter prom, they will not be allowed to return to their car.
7. Once a student and his/her/their guest leaves, they will not be allowed to re-enter.
8. Dinner will begin at 7:00 pm. Students are expected to arrive and be seated by this time.
9. PSHS and Student Council are **NOT** responsible for items misplaced, lost, and/or stolen.
10. PSHS reserves the right to decline the request of attendance of anyone with or without cause. Attendance to prom is a privilege, not a right. Anyone found in violation of these rules will be removed from prom with her/her/their guest and parents/guardians will be notified immediately. Appropriate school discipline may also apply - see the PSHS Student Handbook for guidelines.
