Highlights include 24 personal record performances. Sophomore Tierra Abner won the Varsity 55-meter dash and finished 2nd in the Varsity 200 meter. Senior **Madison Labeck** won the JV 400 meter. Junior **Abby Trentz** finished 3rd in the JV 1600 meter. Sophomore **Vanessa Tuazon** finished 2nd in the JV 55-meter hurdles, 1st in the JV Long Jump, and 2nd in the JV triple jump. Sophomore **Allison Aribeara** won the JV shot put.

This Saturday the team competes at Lewis University for the Southwest Prairie Indoor Conference championships.
